**Option Green: Learn About Energy Efficiency for Homes and Businesses,
March 20 at the East Brunswick Public Library and Online**

Walter S. Martillo's presentation will include detailed information about the different types of residential home energy assessments, rebates and discounts, PSE&G's online Marketplace, the residential electric vehicle charging program and a brief overview of the small business direct install program. Martillo's role involves daily management of field operations and maintenance activities across 36 Solar Generation stations in New Jersey.
